CITY OF SUMMIT NJ DIVISION OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY, STATE AND COMMUNITY HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT (FEDERAL FUNDING)

The NJ Division of Highway Traffic Safety (DHTS) - State and Community Highway Safety Grant (Federal Funding) FY25 grant program provides federal funding for pedestrian safety initiatives. Municipalities and counties with pedestrian safety problems are eligible to apply. Grant funds may be used for the following initiatives: Controlling impaired driving, increasing seat belt usage rates, promoting the proper use of child passenger restraint systems, increasing traffic law enforcement with an emphasis on speed/aggressive and distracted driving, improving safety for bicyclists, pedestrians, motorcyclists, teens, and older drivers, providing additional training of state and local personnel, and improving the collection and analysis of traffic crash data. No matching funds are required for this grant program. This program has a 12-month project period to begin October 1, 2024.

Given the City of Summit's weekday congestion and the high volume of daily pedestrian traffic, further enforcement, education, and engineering activities are required to sustain and improve pedestrian safety. As such, the Summit Police Department is applying for a federally-funded NJ DHTS FY25 State and Community Highway Safety Grant to improve pedestrian safety at targeted locations throughout the City. The Police Department will apply for funding in the amount of \$15,000.

ESTABLISH HOMELESSNESS TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, over the last several years, homelessness in the City of Summit (the “City”) has increased exponentially; and

WHEREAS, as the homeless population increases, it is not uncommon for these individuals to occupy and sleep in public spaces creating a health and safety issue for both the individuals experiencing homelessness and those who come in contact with them regularly; and

WHEREAS, the City cannot address the rise of homelessness alone which requires both the County and the State to work with our municipal government to address this important issue; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council have determined that it is necessary to establish a multi-stakeholder task force (the “Mayor’s Task Force on Homelessness in Summit” or “Task Force”) comprised of elected officials, government entities, non-profits, local businesses, and City residents to assist in addressing issues related to homelessness in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council will assign the Task Force with investigating, identifying, and reporting on potential short- and long-term solutions and reasonable actions that our community can take to address this complex problem; and

WHEREAS, it is the Mayor and Common Council’s desire for this Task Force to help establish a humane and responsible process whereby the City and its partners can connect homeless individuals in the City with state, county and local organizations that productively address and provide assistance including, but not limited to, case management, housing resources, medical and behavioral health care and food.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUMMIT, COUNTY OF UNION, NEW JERSEY RESOLVES:

1. That it does hereby establish the Mayor’s Task Force on Homelessness in Summit.
2. That the charge of the Task Force shall be to collaborate with the appropriate agencies to identify the underlying causes of homelessness in the City, to connect homeless individuals with local organizations that can provide relevant assistance, and to take any other actions necessary and appropriate to assist the City in addressing homelessness.
3. That the Task Force shall meet monthly.
4. That the Task Force shall provide a monthly report to the Common Council on the first business day of each month, starting the month following the first meeting.
5. That the Task Force shall consist of the following members:

- a. The Mayor
- b. Three (3) Common Councilmembers including the Council President (or designee), Councilmember of the Safety and Health Committee ("S/H"), and Councilmember of the Community Programs & Parking Services Committee ("CPPS")
- c. The Chief of Police (or his designee)
- d. The Fire Chief (or his designee)
- e. The Superintendent of Summit Public Schools (or his designee)
- f. One (1) member of the Summit Board of Health
- g. One (1) representative from Overlook Medical Center
- h. At least Three (3), but no more than Ten (10) representatives of Summit-based non-profit organizations which provide assistance to the Summit homeless, designated by the Mayor at her discretion.
- i. Two (2) business owners - one (1) business owner representing the Summit Downtown Special Improvement District and one (1) business owner at large.
- j. Five (5) City residents-at-large.

6. That the Mayor shall appoint the members generally referenced in paragraph 5. h., i., and j. above, with the advice and consent of the Council.
7. That each member referenced in paragraph 5 above shall serve for an initial term to conclude on December 31, 2024, followed by (1) one-year terms for all members appointed or reappointed thereafter, should the Council resolve to renew this resolution.
8. That the Common Council shall appoint a Chair of the Task Force for an initial term to conclude on December 31, 2024.

AUTHORIZE 2024 SUBMITTAL OF 2023 TONNAGE REPORT DATA TO STATE

WHEREAS, the City of Summit has maintained a recycling program which conforms with New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Bureau of Recycling and Planning rules and regulations, and

WHEREAS, the recycling effort in the City of Summit has reduced solid waste flows into landfills and other non-recoverable disposal sites, and

WHEREAS, the City of Summit has incurred expenses associated with recycling that are not offset by revenues from the sale of the recyclable materials, and

WHEREAS, the City of Summit continues to actively promote recycling of as many materials as practicable in order to achieve a minimum recycling rate of fifty percent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUMMIT:

That it endorses the submission of a Recycling Tonnage Report for 2023 to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Bureau of Recycling and Planning.

In 1987, the New Jersey Statewide Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act (the Act), specifically N.J.S.A. 13:1E-99.16, mandated the governing body of each municipality to submit an annual Recycling Tonnage Report summarizing the amount of material recycled during the previous calendar year.

In January 2008, the “Recycling Enhancement Act” specifically P.L. 2007, c. 311, reestablishes funding for local recycling programs through a tax of \$3.00 per ton on all solid waste accepted for disposal or transfer at solid waste facilities, requires the appointment of Certified Recycling Professional and specifies that grants received may only be expended on recycling.

Summit typically receives approximately \$30,000 annually for their efforts. The grant funds are anticipated to be used to maintain and update the recycling area at the Transfer Station as needed, purchase of recycling enhancement amenities for public properties and for the purchase of replacement vehicles used daily to collect corrugated cardboard and co-mingle materials.

Attached to this memo is the 2023 State-mandated tonnage report template, which will be submitted to the State of New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Recycling and Planning in 2024. As additional information may be received from various recycling vendors, the report can be revised as needed if that occurs.

I recommend Council authorizing a resolution for the 2024 submittal of the 2023 Recycling Tonnage Report.

AUTHORIZE SECOND FIVE-YEAR EXTENSION - LEASE PORTION OF 3 CONSTANTINE PLACE FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF ONE MONOPOLE AND RELATED FACILITIES - JUNE 25, 2024 THROUGH JUNE 24, 2029

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2012, Common Council adopted Ordinance No. 12-2975 entitled “Ordinance Declaring Property No Longer Needed for Public Use and Authorizing the Lease of Public Lands Pursuant to R.S. 40A:12-14(a)” allowing for the lease of the vacant portion of Block 1505, Lot 1, more commonly known as 3 Constantine Place, for the construction and maintenance of one monopole and related facilities pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:12-14(a)”, and

WHEREAS, bids to Lease Portion of 3 Constantine Place for the Construction and Maintenance of One Monopole and Related Facilities (“Bid”) were received on February 4, 2014, and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2014, Common Council adopted resolution #36193 awarding the Bid to New York SMSA Limited Partnership d/b/a/ Verizon Wireless, and

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2014, Common Council adopted resolution #36313 authorizing execution of agreement #14-3105 between the City of Summit (“City”) and New York SMSA Limited Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Lessee”) to Lease Portion of 3 Constantine Place for Construction and Maintenance of One Monopole and Related Facilities (“Agreement”) setting forth the respective obligations of the parties, and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2014, the City and Lessee entered the Agreement for an initial term of five (5) years from June 25, 2014 through June 24, 2019, and

WHEREAS, the specifications for the Bid and the Agreement include the initial five-year lease term plus the option to extend the Agreement for up to four (4) additional terms of five (5) years each provided Lessee is not in default under the lease, for a total contract term not to exceed twenty-five (25) years, and

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2019, Common Council adopted resolution #38888 authorizing the first five-year extension option from June 25, 2019 through June 24, 2024, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to extend the Agreement pursuant to the terms and conditions of the June 25, 2014 Agreement for the second five-year extension option June 25, 2024 through June 24, 2029.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUMMIT:

That Agreement #14-3105 with New York SMSA Limited Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless to Lease Portion of 3 Constantine Place for the Construction and Maintenance of One Monopole and Related Facilities be extended under the same terms and conditions of the June 25, 2014 Agreement for a term of five (5) years from June 25, 2024 through June 24, 2029, with an option for two (2) additional terms of five (5) years each for a total lease term not to exceed 25 years, unless Lessee provides the City notice of intention not to renew the Lease not less than ninety (90) days prior to the expiration of any subsequent renewal term.

The City of Summit entered into a lease of real property on a portion of property located at 3 Constantine Place on June 25, 2014, with New York SMSA Limited Partnership, d/b/a/ Verizon Wireless for the purpose of the construction of a communication monopole. Attached is the original 2014 agreement.

The lease term was for five (5) years with an option to renew for four (4) additional five-year terms. The initial five-year term expired on June 25, 2019, at which time Verizon exercised their option of renewing for the contract's first renewal term from June 26, 2019, through June 24, 2024. Verizon would like to continue with their renewal options and intends to renew for a second term of five years from June 25, 2024, through June 24, 2029. After this renewal, they have two more renewal terms available to them, with the final term ending on June 24, 2039.

The lease allows for up to 4 wireless co-locators; currently three (3) co-locators, AT&T, T-Mobile, and DISH have communication equipment on the monopole. Each co-locator was required to enter into a supplement agreement with the lessee, Verizon Wireless. The City receives annual lease payments from each co-locator.

Rent for each year of the term will be the annual rent in effect for the prior year, increased by 3%, including all renewal terms.

To enter into the second five-year option for renewal of the agreement, a resolution will need to be adopted by Council for a five-year term commencing on June 25, 2024 through June 24, 2029. That resolution will then be sent to Verizon for their records to continue without interruption.

**LEASE OF REAL PROPERTY FOR CONSTRUCTION AND
OPERATION OF WIRELESS COMMUNICATION MONOPOLE
AND RELATED SUPPORT FACILITIES**

THIS AGREEMENT entered into as of this 25 day of June, 2014 by and between City of Summit, 512 Springfield Avenue, Summit, New Jersey 07901 ("Lessor"), and NEW YORK SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP d/b/a Verizon Wireless with its principal offices at One Verizon Way, Mail Stop 4AW100, Basking Ridge, New Jersey 07920 ("Lessee").

For good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Premises:

Lessor is the owner of that certain real property known as 3 Constantine Place, Summit, New Jersey as shown on the Tax Map of the City of Summit as Block 1505, Lot 1.

2. Leased Premises:

The Lessor desires to lease to Lessee and Lessee desires to lease from Lessor, a portion of the Premises, as is more particularly set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof, together with all necessary space and easements for access and utilities ("Leased Premises") in order to construct, install, operate and maintain a 150 foot above ground level monopole along with certain wireless telecommunications equipment, and up to a total of five (5) antenna arrays (consisting of up to twelve (12) antennas each array), which may not extend beyond a total of one hundred, fifty (150) feet tall including the height of the monopole, along with fencing and other accessories necessary to the successful and secure operation of the equipment together with a non-exclusive easement for 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for access thereto and to the appropriate, in the discretion of Lessee, source of electrical and telephone facilities.

3. Improvements; Utilities; Access

(a) The Leased Premises shall include a location for installation of a monopole for wireless communications antenna arrays, including without limitation, associated cabling, a base equipment shelter or equipment cabinets and space on the Leased Premises for running of utilities lines, transmission lines other cables and all necessary appurtenances, including without limitation generators and fuel storage tanks (being collectively referred to herein as "Antenna Facilities").

(b) In connection therewith Lessee has the right to do all work necessary for preparing, maintaining, and altering Leased Premises for Lessee's business operations and for installing, removing, replacing, and modifying a personal communications service system facility. All of Lessee's installation work shall occur lien-free and shall be performed at Lessee's sole cost and expense and in a good and workmanlike manner, and in full compliance with local construction code directives. Lessee shall, at Lessee's expense, operate, keep and maintain the Antenna Facilities now or hereafter located on the Leased Premises in commercially reasonable condition and repair during the term of this Lease, normal wear and tear excepted.

(c) Lessee shall pay for the electricity and any of the utilities it consumes in its operations. If permitted by the local utility company servicing the Leased Premises, Lessee shall furnish and install an electrical submeter at the Leased Premises for the measurement of electric power used by the Lessee's installation. Lessee shall pay for such power consumption thirty (30) days after receipt of invoice from Lessor indicating the usage amount.

(d) As partial consideration for Rent paid under this Lease, Lessor hereby grants Lessee easements on, under and across the Premises for ingress, egress, utilities and access to the Leased Premises

adequate to install and maintain utilities, including, not limited to, the installation of power and telephone service cable, and to service the Leased Premises and the Antenna Facilities at all times during the Term of this Lease (collectively, the "Easements"). The Easements provided hereunder shall have the same term as this Lease.

4 Permitted Use:

The Leased Premises may be used by Lessee for the transmission and reception of communications signals and for the antennas, equipment shelters and/or cabinets and related activities.

The City, County and emergency services shall have the right to use the monopole constructed by Lessee for their communications operation at no cost. The location of the emergency services antennas shall be determined by mutual consent of the Lessor and the Lessee. The emergency services antennas may exceed the height of the monopole. The Lessor may, upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to Lessee, mount communications antennas on the monopole, at its cost and expense, but without obligation to pay a share of the costs of development and maintenance of the site. The Lessor shall not install or permit the installation of any radio equipment interfering with or restricting the operations of Lessee.

5. Co-location:

It is the intended and accepted that in addition to the Permitted Use by the Lessee, the Leased Premises and Antenna Facilities shall be made available for use by up to four (4) wireless tenants (Co-Locators). Each Co-Locator shall enter into a lease with the Lessee in a form, and for an amount, acceptable to the Lessor which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld. Co-Location installation designs shall also be submitted to Lessor for approval before the execution of any Co-Location leases. Said approval shall not be unreasonably withheld. The lease rate paid by all Co-Locators for tower and ground space shall be the rate bid by each Co-Locator in response to the initial, or subsequent, bid solicitations by Lessor but in no case less than the minimum bid. Each Co-Locator shall have its choice of available space on the monopole and in the compound in descending order of amount of bid submitted. Co-Location rent payments shall be made to the Lessee and Lessee shall in turn pay to the Lessor one hundred percent (100%) of all co-location rental revenue within 30 days of receipt of any payments, unless alternate lease arrangements of equal value are approved by the Lessor. The Lessee's operation should occur to the greatest degree possible so as not to interfere with other users on the Leased Premises.

6. Term:

The term of this Agreement (the "Initial Term") is five (5) years, commencing on the date ("Commencement Date") both Lessee and Lessor have executed this Agreement. Provided Lessee is not in Default under this Lease, the Lessee shall have the option to renew this Agreement for four (4) additional terms (each a "Renewal Term") of five (5) years each, unless Lessee provides Lessor notice of intention not to renew not less than 90 days prior to the expiration of the Initial Term or any subsequent Renewal Term.

7. Rent:

The payment of rent shall be made on an annual basis, with the Rent for the first year of the Term in an amount of thirty thousand, twelve and 00/100 dollars (\$30,012.00) (until increased as set forth herein) due no later than 60 days after the issuance of a building permit. Rent during each year of the Term (including any Renewal Term) will be the annual rent in effect for the prior year increased by three percent (3%). As a prerequisite for the payment of any Rent by Lessee, Lessor shall provide a fully-executed Internal Revenue Service Form W-9, or equivalent in a form acceptable to Lessee, for any party to whom rental payments are to be made pursuant to the this Lease.

8. Construction of Monopole:

In the event the Lessee is the highest or only bidder, it shall be considered the Lead Bidder and shall be responsible for the construction and maintenance of a new 150 foot monopole and other areas on the site. If there are other successful bidders/Co-Locators, the other successful bidders/Co-Locators shall be responsible to reimburse the Lead Bidder for their pro rata share of the costs of development and maintenance of the site. If there are other future Co-Locators, the other future Co-Locators shall be responsible to reimburse the Lead Bidder for their pro rata share of the costs of development and maintenance of the site.

9. Compliance with Statutes, Regulations and Approvals:

Lessee shall erect, maintain and operate its Antennae Facilities in accordance with site standards, state statutes, ordinances, rules, and regulations now in effect or that hereafter may be issued by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) or any governing bodies with jurisdiction. Lessee shall proceed diligently to obtain all necessary permits. If the Lessee is unable, after diligent effort, to obtain necessary permits, then either party without further obligation may cancel this Agreement.

10. Maintenance:

Lessee shall, at its own expense, maintain any equipment on or attached to the Leased Premises in a safe condition, in good repair, and in a manner suitable to Lessor. Lessee shall have sole responsibility for the maintenance, repair, and security of its equipment, personal property, Antennae Facilities, and leasehold improvements, and shall keep the same in good repair and condition during the Agreement term.

11. Taxes:

Lessee shall pay all real and personal property taxes and assessments for the Leased Premises, if any, which become due and payable during the term of this Agreement as a result of Lessee's use of the Leased Premises. All such payments shall be made by Lessee, and evidence of all such payments shall be provided to Lessor at least ten (10) days prior to the delinquency date of the payment. Lessee shall pay all taxes on its personal property on the Leased Premises. The Lessee shall have the right to file an appeal in a court of competent jurisdiction for any imposition of taxes imposed pursuant to this paragraph.

12. Assignment and Subletting:

The Lessee shall not assign its lease, or any interest in its lease, or sublet the Leased Premises, or any part of the premises, or any right or privilege appurtenant to it, or allow any person other than the Lessee and Lessee's agents and employees to occupy or use the premises or any part of them, without first obtaining the Lessor's express written consent. The Lessor's express written consent to one assignment, sublease, or use shall not constitute consent to any other, or otherwise unauthorized, assignment or sublease. Any subsequent assignment or sublease or occupancy or use by another person without the Lessor's express written consent shall be void and shall terminate at the Lessor's option. This prohibition against assigning or subletting shall apply to the entire Leased Premises. Notwithstanding this prohibition, a Lessee shall have the right, without the Lessor's express written consent to assign its lease or sublease with demised premises to any corporation affiliated with lessee, namely: (1) a parent corporation of lessee, (2) a wholly owned subsidiary corporation of lessee or lessee's parent corporation, (3) any corporation succeeding to substantially all of the assets as a result of a consolidation or merger, or (4) any corporation to which all or substantially all of the assets of lessee have been sold. Such an assignment, without the Lessor's express written consent, shall be valid only if: (1) the parent corporation of lessee or

the wholly owned subsidiary corporation of lessee or lessee's parent corporation have a net worth prior the assignment of the sublease, and (2) the assigning sublessee or transferee assumes, by written agreement, all of Lessee's obligations under its lease. Any such assignment or sublease or transfer shall not release the lessee from any and all or its obligations under this Agreement.

13. Marking and Lighting Requirements:

Lessee acknowledges that it, and not Lessor, shall be responsible for compliance with all marking and lighting requirements of the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") and the FCC as a result of Lessee's use of the Leased Premises. Lessee shall indemnify and hold Lessor harmless from any fines or other liabilities caused by Lessee's failure to comply with such requirements. Should Lessee be cited by either the FCC or FAA because of non-compliance and, should Lessee fail to cure the conditions of non-compliance within the time frame allowed by the citing agency, Lessor may terminate this Lease immediately on notice to Lessee.

14. Waiver of Lessor's Lien:

- A. Lessor waives any lien rights it may have concerning the Lessee Antenna facilities which are deemed Lessee's personal property and not fixtures, and Lessee has the right to remove the same at any time without Lessor's consent.
- B. Lessor acknowledges that Lessee may enter into a financing arrangement including promissory notes and financial and security agreements for the financing of the Lessee Antenna facilities (the "Collateral") with a third-party financing entity (and may in the future enter into additional financing arrangements with other financing entities). In connection therewith, Lessor (i) consents to the installation of the Collateral; (ii) disclaims any interest in the Collateral, as fixtures or otherwise; and (iii) agrees that the Collateral shall be exempt from execution, foreclosure, sale, levy, attachment, or distress for any Rent due or to become due and that such Collateral may be removed at any time without recourse to legal proceedings.

15. Default and Lessor's Remedies:

If either party is in default under this Agreement for a period of 30 days following receipt of written notice from the non-defaulting party, the non-defaulting party may pursue any remedies available to it against the defaulting party at law or in equity, including, but not limited to, the right to terminate this Agreement. If a non-monetary default cannot reasonably be cured within a 30-day period, this Agreement may not be terminated if the defaulting party commences action to cure the default within the 30-day period and proceeds with due diligence to fully cure the default.

16. Termination; Removal of Abandoned Monopole and Antennae and at Termination of Lease:

Notwithstanding any provision contained in this Agreement, Lessee may, in Lessee's sole and absolute discretion and at any time and for any or no reason, terminate this Agreement by delivering prior written notice to Lessor. Lessee shall then be obligated to remove its antennas and all of its equipment. If the Lessee does not operate the monopole or any antenna for a period of thirty (30) consecutive days, Lessor may at its option, by written notice to Lessee, designate a date, not less than fifteen (15) days from the giving of such notice, on which this Lease shall terminate, and thereupon on such date this Lease and all rights of Lessee hereunder shall terminate. Lessee shall remove all of its antennas from the monopole and all of its equipment from the equipment room within thirty (30) days of receipt of such notice from the Lessor. If the monopole or any antenna is rendered obsolete or outdated by advances in technology, it shall be removed or modified. If there are two or more users of the monopole, then the monopole shall not be removed until all users cease using the monopole. At the termination of this lease the monopole and all related facilities shall be removed and the property restored as nearly as possible to its original condition at the commencement of the Lease. At the time of delivery of

certificate(s) of insurance the Lessee shall also deliver an appropriate performance bond or other suitable guarantee in a face amount of not less than 120% of the cost as determined by the City Engineer to remove the monopole, all equipment and equipment rooms and restore the property.

17. Indemnity:

The Lessee shall indemnify and save harmless the Lessor from and against any and all loss, injury, liabilities, obligations, damages, penalties, claims, costs, charges and expenses including reasonable architects' and attorneys' fees (except those arising out of intentional acts and/or from the negligence of the Lessor, its agents or representatives), which may be imposed upon or incurred by or asserted against the Lessor by reason of any of the following occurring during the term of this Lease arising out of the Lessee's or Co-Locator's use or occupancy of the Leased Premises:

- (a) Any work or anything done in, on, or about the Leased Premises or any party thereof by direct or open authority of the Lessee;
- (b) Any use, nonuse, possession, occupation, condition, operation, maintenance, or management of the Leased Premises;
- (c) Any negligence of the Lessee or any agent, contractor, subcontractor, employee, licensee, or invitee of the Lessee;
- (d) Any accident, injury, or damage to any person or property occurring in, on, or about the Leased Premises, or any part thereof, and any accident, injury, or damage to any person or property not in, on, or about the Leased premises but caused by the Lessee's equipment and facilities and/or operations;
- (e) Any failure on the part of the Lessee to perform or comply with any of the agreements, terms, or conditions contained in this Lease on its part to be performed or complied with; and
- (f) Any interference with television and radio transmission and reception in the City of Summit caused by the Lessee's equipment and facilities and/or operations;

Provided the Lessor shall provide the Lessee prompt notice of any claim against the Lessor which might form the basis of any liability on the part of the Lessee under this paragraph. The Lessor shall not settle, compromise, or defend any such claim without the approval of the Lessee. In the event that any action or proceeding shall be brought against the Lessor by reason of any claim covered by this paragraph, the Lessee, upon written notice from the Lessor, will at the Lessee's sole cost and expense resist or defend same.

18. Insurance:

The Lessee, at its own expense, shall purchase and maintain such insurance as outlined below to cover claims which may arise out of or result from its operations under the lease, whether such operations be by the Lessee or by any contractor and/or subcontractor of the Lessee, or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by the Lessee, or by anyone for whose acts the Lessee may be liable. The insurance shall include:

- A. Worker's compensation, disability benefits and other similar employee benefit acts coverage, which are applicable to the work to be performed, in amounts and for coverage as required by all applicable federal, state, maritime, and other laws.
- B. Commercial General Liability Insurance for bodily injury and property damage liability combined with limits of at least \$5,000,000.00 each Occurrence and \$5,000,000.00

General Aggregate and \$2,000,000.00 Products/Completed Operations, and with not less than a \$1,000,000.00 limit for Personal Injury & Advertising Injury Liability, covering hazards of operations including, but not limited to, collapse and underground coverage, independent contractor coverage, broad form property damage liability coverage, and broad form contractual coverage for liability assumed under this Agreement.

- C. Automobile Liability Insurance for not less than a Combined Single Limit of Liability for bodily injury and property damage liability of \$1,000,000.00 Each Occurrence. The policy must include coverage for all owned (if any), hired and non-owned automobiles and trucks.
- D. Employers' Liability Insurance for not less than the limits of liability as follows:
 \$500,000.00 each accident for Bodily Injury by Accident
 \$500,000.00 policy limit for Bodily Injury by Disease
 \$500,000.00 each employee for Bodily Injury by Disease
- E. Reserved.
- F. Reserved.
- G. The minimum amount of insurance, which the Lessee shall require each Subcontractor to carry, shall be in the same amounts as specified for the Lessee.
- H. It is understood and agreed that the insurer will be rated not less than A- (Excellent) by "Bests Insurance Guide" and a financial category of no lower than "VI".
- I. All insurance policies of Lessee shall be primary to any insurance carried by Lessor.
- J. Upon execution of the contract and prior to the start of construction, the Lessee shall, at its sole cost and expense, furnish and deliver to Lessor a Certificate of Insurance evidencing the required insurance and naming the City of Summit as an additional insured on the General Liability. Lessee shall furnish replacement certificates of insurance at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of any required coverage, as insurance must be maintained continuously during the entire term of this agreement.
- K. Furnishing acceptable evidence of insurance as required hereunder shall not relieve Lessee from any liability or obligation for which it is otherwise liable under the terms of this Agreement.

19. Hazardous Substance Indemnification:

Lessor represents that it has no knowledge of any substance, chemical, or waste (collectively "substance") on the Leased Premises that is identified as hazardous, toxic, or dangerous in any applicable federal, state or local law or regulation. Lessee will not introduce or use any such substance on the Leased Premises in violation of any applicable law. Lessor shall hold Lessee harmless and indemnify Lessee from, and assume all duties, responsibility and liability at Lessor's sole cost and expense, for all duties, responsibilities, and liability (for payment of penalties, sanctions, forfeitures, losses, costs, or damages), and for responding to any action, notice, claim, order, summons, citation, directive, litigation, investigation or proceeding which is in any way related to: (a) failure to comply with any environmental or industrial hygiene law, including without limitation any regulations, guidelines, standards, or policies of any governmental authorities regulating or imposing standards of liability or standards of conduct with regard to any environmental or industrial hygiene concerns or conditions as may now or at any time hereafter be in effect, unless such non-compliance results from conditions caused by Lessee; and (b) any environmental or industrial hygiene conditions arising out of or in any way related to the condition

of the Property or activities conducted thereon, unless such environmental conditions are caused by Lessee.

20. Subordination of Mortgage:

Any mortgage now or subsequently placed upon any property of which the Leased Premises are a part shall be deemed to be prior in time and senior to the rights of the Lessee under this Agreement. Lessee subordinates all of its interest in the leasehold estate created by this Agreement to the lien of any such mortgage. Lessee shall, at Lessor's request, execute any additional documents necessary to indicate this.

21. Acceptance of Leased Premises:

By taking possession of the Leased Premises, Lessee accepts the premises in the condition existing as of the Commencement Date. Lessor makes no representation or warranty with respect to the condition of the Leased Premises and Lessor shall not be liable for any latent or patent defect in the Leased Premises.

22. Estoppel Certificate:

Lessee shall, at any time and from time to time upon not less than ten (10) days prior request by Lessor, deliver to Lessor a statement in writing certifying that (a) the Agreement is unmodified and in full force (or if there have been modifications, that the Agreement is in full force as modified and identifying the modifications); (b) the dates to which rent and other charges have been paid; (c) so far as the person making the certificate knows, Lessor is not in default under any provisions of the Agreement; and (d) such other matters as Lessor may reasonably request.

23. Interference:

Lessee agrees to have installed equipment of the type and frequency that will not cause measurable interference to Lessor, Co-Locators, other current lessees of the Premises or neighboring landowners. In the event Lessee's equipment causes such interference, and after Lessor has notified Lessee of such interference, Lessee will take all steps necessary to correct and eliminate the interference. The Lessor will not permit the installation of any future equipment that results in technical interference problems with the Lessee's or other Co-Locators then exiting equipment.

24. Tests and Construction:

Lessee shall have the right at any time following the full execution of this Agreement to enter upon the Leased Premises for the purposes of making appropriate engineering and boundary surveys, inspections, soil test borings and other reasonably necessary tests for construction of the Antennae Facilities. Upon Lessee's request, Lessor agrees to provide promptly to Lessee copies of all plans, specifications, surveys and maps for the Premises.

25. Notices:

All notices, requests, demands, and other communications hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed given if personally delivered or mailed, certified mail, return receipt requested; to the following addresses:

26. Successors and Assigns:

This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their respective successors, and assigns.

27. Non-Waiver:

Failure of Lessor to insist on strict performance of any of the conditions, covenants, terms or provisions of this Agreement or to exercise any of its rights hereunder shall not waive such rights, but Lessor shall have the rights to enforce such rights at any time and take such action as might be lawful or authorized hereunder, either in law or equity. The receipt of any sum paid by Lessee to Lessor after a breach of this Agreement shall not be deemed a waiver of such breach unless expressly set forth in writing.

28. Attorneys' Fees

In the event the Lessor is required to employ the services of an attorney to enforce any of the Lessor's rights under this Agreement, then the Lessor shall be entitled to recover from Lessee all reasonable attorneys' fees incurred.

29. Miscellaneous:

- A. Lessor and Lessee represent that each, respectively, has the full right, power, and authority to execute this Agreement.
- B. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement and understanding of the parties and supersedes all offers, negotiations, and other agreements of any kind. There are no representations or understandings of any kind not set forth herein. Any modification of or amendment to this Agreement must be in writing and executed by both parties.
- C. If requested by Lessee, Lessor agrees promptly to execute and deliver to Lessee a recordable Memorandum of this Agreement in the form of Exhibit B.
- D. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
- E. If any term of this Agreement is found to be void or invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining terms of this Agreement, which shall continue in full force and effect.
- F. This Lease may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute a single instrument.





W I T N E S S E T H:

1. 2. If such charge or compensation shall be in arrears or unpaid for ten (10) days after the due date thereof as aforesaid, or if default shall be made in any of the conditions or agreements herein contained on behalf of Licensee to be kept or performed, this license shall, at the option of Licensor, terminate ten (10) days after the notice of such election sent by mail to Licensee addressed either to the Licensed Property or to any other address known to Licensor.

3. On the termination of this License, Licensee shall remove all objects placed on the Licensed Property and leave same in a condition satisfactory to Licensor, and in default thereof, Licensor may do the same at the cost and expense of Licensee, which Licensee agrees to pay upon presentation of a bill therefor; and on such termination it shall be lawful for Licensor to re-enter upon the Licensed Property, to have, repossess and enjoy the same again.

4. Licensee agrees that the payment of the aforesaid charge or compensation shall not in any way restrict the right of Licensor to terminate this Agreement as herein provided, nor be construed as establishing any term during which the Agreement is to continue.

5. The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has re-proposed the following documents for the administration of the FFY2024/SFY2025 Clean Water State Revolving Fund (“CWSRF”) and the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (“DWSRF”):

- Amended Proposed Drinking Water Intended Use Plan for Federal Fiscal Year 2024/ State Fiscal Year 2025
- Amended Proposed Clean Water Intended Use Plan for Federal Fiscal Year 2024/ State Fiscal Year 2025

The FFY 2024 CWSRF and DWSRF IUPs were proposed on December 20, 2023, with a 30-day comment period. The Department is re-proposing both IUPs and holding a 10-day comment period on the proposed amendments. All comments submitted prior to the close of the comment period will be considered in the preparation of the final CWSRF IUP and DWSRF IUP. ESTABLISH MAYOR'S TASK FORCE ON HOMELESSNESS IN SUMMIT

WHEREAS, over the last several years, homelessness in the City of Summit (the “City”) has increased; and

WHEREAS, as the homeless population increases, more individuals are left residing and sleeping in public spaces; and

WHEREAS, this situation presents challenges to the health and safety of the homeless and also impacts the broader community, underscoring the need for compassionate and effective solutions;

WHEREAS, the City cannot address the rise of homelessness alone which requires both the County and the State to work with our municipal government to address this important issue; and

WHEREAS, the City aspires to minimize and/or end homelessness in Summit; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council have determined that it is necessary to establish a multi-stakeholder task force (the “Mayor’s Task Force on Homelessness in Summit” or “Task Force”) comprised of elected officials, government entities, non-profits, local businesses, and City residents to assist in addressing issues related to homelessness in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Common Council will assign the Task Force to investigate, identify, and report on potential short- and long-term solutions and reasonable actions that our community can take to address this complex problem; and

WHEREAS, it is the Mayor and Common Council’s desire for this Task Force to help establish a humane and responsible process whereby the City and its partners can connect homeless individuals in the City with state, county and local organizations that productively address and provide assistance including, but not limited to, case management, housing resources, medical and behavioral health care and food.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUMMIT, COUNTY OF UNION, NEW JERSEY:

1. That it does hereby establish the Mayor’s Task Force on Homelessness in Summit.
2. That the charge of the Task Force shall be to collaborate with the appropriate agencies to identify the underlying causes of homelessness in the City, to connect homeless individuals with local organizations that can provide relevant assistance, and to take any other actions necessary and appropriate to assist the City in addressing homelessness.
3. That the Task Force shall meet monthly.

4. That the Task Force shall provide a monthly report to the Common Council on the first business day of each month, starting the month following the first meeting.
5. That the Task Force shall consist of the following members:
 - a. The Mayor
 - b. Three (3) Common Councilmembers including the Council President (or designee), Councilmember of the Safety and Health Committee (“S/H”), and Councilmember of the Community Programs & Parking Services Committee (“CPPS”)
 - c. The Chief of Police (or his designee)
 - d. The Fire Chief (or his designee)
 - e. The Superintendent of Summit Public Schools (or his designee)
 - f. One (1) member of the Summit Board of Health
 - g. One (1) representative from Overlook Medical Center
 - h. At least Three (3), but no more than Ten (10) representatives of Summit-based non-profit organizations which provide assistance to the Summit homeless, designated by the Mayor at her discretion.
 - i. Two (2) business owners - one (1) business owner representing the Summit Downtown Special Improvement District and one (1) business owner at large.
 - j. Five (5) City residents-at-large.
6. That the Mayor shall appoint the members generally referenced in paragraph 5. h., i., and j. above, with the advice and consent of the Council.
7. That each member referenced in paragraph 5 above shall serve for an initial term to conclude on December 31, 2024, followed by (1) one-year terms for all members appointed or reappointed thereafter, should the Council resolve to renew this resolution.
8. That the Common Council shall appoint a Chair of the Task Force for an initial term to conclude on December 31, 2024.
