Information on Online Resident and Employee Parking and Disposal Permits Deadlines

SUMMIT, N.J., November 13, 2020 – The deadline for residents to renew annual parking and municipal disposal center permits online has been extended to November 30, 2020. New permits will be valid through October 31, 2021, and are required by the City of Summit for all residents to park in municipal parking lots and garages and to use the City of Summit Transfer Station at 40 New Providence Ave.

Beginning on Monday, November 16, downtown employees are able to renew annual parking permits online. The deadline for renewal is December 30, 2020. Permits are required by the City of Summit for downtown employees to park in designated municipal lots and garages.

The Parking Services Agency is available to assist residents and downtown employees with the permit renewal process if they are unable to initiate the process online. Due to COVID-19 pandemic restrictions, appointments are required for in-office assistance, and are available Monday to Friday from 9AM to 12PM. Masks and social distancing are required.
