### City Adds Appointments for Summit Transfer Station Tuesday and Friday Hours

SUMMIT, NJ, April 22, 2020 – The City of Summit is increasing the number of daily [appointments](#) from 20 to 40 hourly to accommodate residents using its Municipal Transfer Station on Tuesdays and Fridays from 7:30AM to 2:30PM. Each appointment is for 15-minutes, and must be scheduled in advance through the City of Summit [website](#). If residents do not have online access, they may call 908-273-6404 to schedule.

The Department of Community Services is also expanding its Dial-a-Truck service, offered on the third week of each month, from 60 to 75 appointments. Call 908-273-6404 to schedule.

When accessing the Municipal Transfer Station, residents must wear a face covering during appointments, and social distancing is required.

Appointment times will be strictly enforced as there are a limited number of appointments scheduled each day. Residents are able to book one appointment weekly and will be required to provide name, address, phone, active email address and [registered](#) license plate information when scheduling an appointment.

The Transfer Station will be open for drop-off only. The following restrictions apply at this time:

- No coupons, temporary passes, U-Hauls or borrowed vehicles will be permitted.
- No commercial vehicles or landscapers will be allowed.
- No pick up of mulch, wood chips or scrap metal.
- The waste oil and book sheds will not be available during this time period.
- No construction and demolition waste will be accepted.

Residents are encouraged to continue to recycle cardboard and other materials curbside on Thursdays instead of dropping off at the Municipal Transfer Station.
