Summit Family Aquatic Center Opening Day is July 1, 2020

SUMMIT, N.J., June 12, 2020 – The Summit Department of Community Programs has announced opening day for its Summit Family Aquatic Center 2020 season will be on Wednesday, July 1, 2020. [Registration](#) for seasonal membership is currently open online.

Due to ongoing COVID-19 outbreak restrictions from the State of New Jersey, capacity will be reduced by 50 percent each day to 600 attendees maximum. Tables will be available, but chairs will not. Members are invited to bring a chair of their own. Other mandatory safety protocols and state guidelines can be viewed on the [Summit Family Aquatic Center](#) webpage.

The facility will be open Monday to Friday from 9AM to 8PM, and from 11AM to 8PM on weekends. Lap swim will be held weekdays from 9AM to 10AM. The main pool will be open from 10AM to 12PM weekdays for the recreation summer camp only. Members will have access to the main pool from 12PM to 8PM and the leisure pool from 10AM to 8PM weekdays. For both pools, weekend hours are from 11AM to 8PM.

The annual resident membership rate for families is \$395, \$160 for individuals, and \$70 for senior citizens. Non-resident memberships for families are \$790, \$320 for individuals and \$160 for senior citizens.

The Summit Family Aquatic Center is located at 100 Ashwood Ave. The award-winning facility has been recognized for its design and programming by the [New Jersey Recreation and Parks Association](#) and by [Aquatics International](#).
