Summit Police Department Receives Report of Burglary at Aston Martin Dealership

SUMMIT, NJ, January 23, 2023 – Summit Police Department received a report of a burglary at the Aston Martin Summit on Saturday, January 21, 2023. The dealership is located at 326 Morris Ave in Summit.

At approximately 6:48AM, three male suspects forcibly entered the dealership through a service bay door on the north side of the building. The suspects located and removed several key fobs from the building and used them to steal a 2021 Aston Martin DBX and a 2022 BMW 8 series from the parking lot. The suspects were seen operating a two-door matte black BMW X8 with dark tinted windows and a temporary license plate.
