Holiday Events and Information through December 2022

SUMMIT, NJ, November 17, 2022 – The City of Summit is announcing the following holiday events taking place throughout November and December 2022.

On Sunday, November 27, the Department of Community Programs will host the annual Miracle on Elm Street event and holiday tree lighting with Mayor Nora Radest. Miracle on Elm Street will take place from 1PM to 6PM, with ice skating in the Elm Street parking lot. Attendees will have the opportunity to decorate cookies and enjoy bonfires and free hot beverages. Musical and entertainment acts will perform on the Village Green. The tree lighting will take place at approximately 5PM, and the Summit Fire Department will assist with Santa's arrival to the Village Green. Photos with Santa will be offered to attendees. Temple Sinai of Summit will host a menorah lighting ceremony on Sunday, December 18, from 5PM to 6PM on the Village Green. Members of the public are invited to attend.

Summit Downtown, Inc. (SDI) will host Small Business Saturday on Saturday, November 26 from 1 to 4PM in downtown Summit. Many businesses will feature special offers and merchandise for the day. Carriages and Carolers will also begin on Saturday, November 26, and continue Saturdays December 3, 10, and 17 from 1 to 4PM. Residents can enjoy holiday music and a free horse and carriage ride around downtown Summit. The boarding location will be Lyric Park, on the corner of Beechwood Road and Bank Street.

The HillTop Elf Scavenger Hunt will run from November 26 until December 17. The elves will be hidden within downtown Summit businesses or in storefront windows. Scavenger hunt forms can be picked up at any participating business or downloaded from the SDI website. There is no purchase necessary to participate. Participants should indicate where each elf is located at the participating business on the form. Completed forms must be turned in to any participating business by 4PM on Saturday, December 17, to be entered to win a \$500 VISA gift card that can be used at over 100 Summit businesses. 10 runner ups will each win \$100 gift cards. The winning forms will be drawn on Monday, December 19, and winners will be notified by email.

Celebrate in Summit will be held on Saturday, December 17 from 1 to 4PM, an event to celebrate the holiday season in Summit. There will be live music throughout the downtown area, and Santa Claus will join the horse and carriage rides beginning at Lyric Park. All activities are free to the public.

The Summit Farmers Market has been extended to include Sundays December 4, 11, and 18 from 8AM to 12PM, in the Park & Shop Lot on the corner of Deforest Avenue and Woodland Avenue. The Farmers Market will be closed on Sunday, November 27 and Sunday, December 25.
