Bike Rodeo to be held September 10

SUMMIT, N.J., August 28, 2024 –The City of Summit will host a bike rodeo and pedestrian safety fair on Tuesday, September 10, at Soldiers Memorial Field located at 5 Myrtle Avenue, beginning at 4:30PM. The event is part of the Mayors Wellness Campaign.

Children are encouraged to bring their bike and helmet to this free event that will encourage participants to have fun while engaging with bicycle safety messaging. Representatives from Avenues in Motion will perform helmet fit checks and basic bicycle maintenance inspections. Participants can ride through an obstacle course and visit stations that will highlight various bicycle skills and safety scenarios riders may encounter on the road.

“I hope many of our young residents attend what is sure to be an exciting event,” says Summit Mayor Elizabeth Fagan, MD. “This event will encourage riders to practice safe biking, enhance their skills, and help them become more confident in their ability to apply these skills while biking around town.”
