Summit Hosts its Annual National Night Out Against Crime on Tuesday, August 3

SUMMIT, N.J., July 23, 2021 – The Summit Police Department is hosting Summit's annual *National Night Out Against Crime* on Tuesday, August 3, 2021 from 6PM to 9PM on the Village Green located at 356 Broad St. in Summit, New Jersey.

Summit is joining thousands of communities around the United States in celebrating National Night Out, a community-building event that takes place annually on the first Tuesday in August. Featuring a variety of municipal, county, state, and federal-level agencies, National Night Out provides a chance for community members to come together to view displays and demonstrations by Union County SWAT, NJ State Police and K-9 along with Summit Police, Summit Fire Department, Summit Volunteer First Aid Squad, and the Division of Public Works.

At 6PM, food trucks will be available and entertainment will begin. The Circus Time circus will be performing at 6:15PM followed by the annual Blessing of the Badges at 7PM. The band *Twice Heard* will perform on the main stage from 7:15PM to 8:45PM. Free hot dogs will be provided at Summit PAL food cart.

Summit's 2021 National Night Out is co-hosted by the Department of Community Programs and sponsored by the Summit PAL.
