Employment Opportunity for School Crossing Guards

SUMMIT, NJ, September 3, 2020 – The City of Summit Police Department is hiring additional school crossing guards for two shifts per day from 7:45AM to 8:30AM and 12:15PM to 1PM Monday through Friday when school is in session during the COVID-19 pandemic. When the district returns to a normal schedule, the afternoon shift will be from 3PM to 3:45PM.

School crossing guards are paid \$34 per day. An incentive bonus of three full days of pay is given to those with perfect attendance records for the school year. If schools declare a snow day, crossing guards will be paid provided they work the day before and after the snow day. Uniforms and training are provided. Crossing guards must wear a face covering at all times while in close proximity to others.

Applicants must be at least 18 years old and provide their own transportation to crossing posts. Applications are available at the Summit Police Department located at 512 Springfield Avenue or in the employment section of the City of Summit [website](#).
