Summit Police Department seeking School Crossing Guards

SUMMIT, N.J., February 26, 2020 – The City of Summit Police Department is seeking applicants for the position of School Crossing Guard to work at crossing posts near Summit public schools. There are multiple openings for the position.

Crossing guards will work two shifts per day from 7:45AM to 8:30AM and 12:15PM to 1PM Monday through Friday when school is in session during the COVID-19 pandemic. When the district returns to a normal schedule, the afternoon shift will be from 3PM to 3:45PM. Uniforms and training will be provided by the Summit Police Department. Crossing guards must wear a face covering at all times while in close proximity to others.

School crossing guards are paid \$34 per day. An incentive bonus of three full days of pay is given to those with perfect attendance records for the school year. In the event of a snow day for Summit public schools, crossing guards will be paid provided they work the day before and after the snow day.

Applicants must be at least 18 years old and provide their own transportation to crossing posts. Applications are available on the city [website](#) and at the Summit Police Department located at 512 Springfield Avenue, and may be submitted in person or [online](#).
