URGENT RECALL NOTICE

Canned Tuna

Certain canned tuna products sold at Costco, Trader Joe's, Walmart, and other grocers are being recalled due to botulism risks, per the FDA (Feb. 10, 2025).

A defective pull-tab lid may cause seal failure, leading to contamination with Clostridium botulinum, a potentially fatal toxin. Do not consume, even if it looks or smells normal.
