78th annual Fourth of July Celebration to be held on Friday, July 4, 2025

SUMMIT, N.J., June 17, 2025 –The City of Summit’s 78th annual Fourth of July celebration will take place on Friday, July 4, 2025, at Soldiers Memorial Field, located at 5 Myrtle Avenue. The community celebration will include entertainment, rides and amusements, and a food court.

The event will begin with a flag raising ceremony at noon, followed by a decorated bicycle parade for children at 12:15PM. Entertainment will include concerts beginning at 1PM. The event will conclude with a fireworks display beginning at 9:15PM.

The walking track, playground, tennis courts, and lower fields at Memorial Field will close at 1PM to prepare for the fireworks display. Roads adjacent to the field will close to vehicle traffic at 6PM. The parking lot on Ashland Road next to the Memorial Field tennis courts will be closed all day on July 4. Handicapped parking will be available at the intersection of Watchung Place and Tulip Street.
