2022 National Night Out to be held on August 2 on the Village Green

SUMMIT, NJ, July 13, 2022 – The Summit Police Department and Department of Community Programs are announcing the 2022 National Night Out will take place on Tuesday, August 2, 2022, beginning at 6PM on the Village Green, located at 365 Broad Street.

Summit will join thousands of communities around the United States to celebrate National Night Out, a community-building event that takes place annually on the first Tuesday of August. Featuring a variety of state, federal, and municipal level agencies, National Night Out provides a chance for community members to come together with law enforcement individuals.

The event will feature displays and demonstrations by the US Coast Guard, US National Guard, Union County SWAT, NJ State Police, and K-9 unit, along with Summit Police, Fire, EMS, and Division of Public Works.
