



Summit Hometown Heroes Instructions for Applicants

Summit is seeking to honor its local veterans and those currently serving in the United States Armed Forces. The annual application deadline is March 31. Applications are being accepted on a rolling basis.

Eligibility Requirements

An individual is eligible to participate if they are serving or have served in any one of the following branches of the United States Armed Forces:

- Air Force
- Army
- Coast Guard
- Marines
- Navy

*United States Merchant Marine and Women Airforce Service Pilots in World War II also accepted

Applicants must also meet the following criteria:

- Are active duty, retired, honorably discharged, or killed in action (deceased individuals may be honored by their family)
- Have lived in Summit at any time in the past or present, or employed by the City of Summit or Summit Board of Education, or are current or former volunteers in the Summit EMS, Police Auxiliary or Volunteer Fire Division

The City of Summit reserves the right to remove a banner for any reason.
