



E-BIKE & E-SCOOTER ORDINANCE

NEW RULES FOR THESE DEVICES



Prohibited on any sidewalks or pedestrian pathway within the city.



May only be operated on roadways where bicycles are permitted.

PENALTIES & FINES

- » Any person found violating this ordinance is subject to a fine not exceeding \$500.
- » Police may confiscate the device and obtain person's name, address, phone number, and age.
- » Any confiscated device will be returned after 24 hours upon proof of ownership.
- » If under 17 years of age, the device will be returned to a parent or guardian.

NEW RULES FOR NON-MOTORIZED TRANSPORTATION DEVICES




E-bike ordinance



The new Summit ordinance also provides new restrictions for non-motorized bikes, scooters, skateboards, and roller blades/skates.



Prohibited from operating on sidewalks, benches, rails, walls, and other infrastructure on certain streets in the downtown district.



Outside of the downtown district, individuals may operate these devices on sidewalks but must slow down and yield right of way to pedestrians.



Failure to comply will result in a fine not exceeding \$100
