### **Summit Bike Rodeo to be held October 7 and 9**

SUMMIT, NJ, September 24, 2025 – The City of Summit is announcing two bike rodeos and pedestrian safety fairs will be held in October 2025. Children are encouraged to bring their bike and helmet to these free events that will encourage participants to have fun while engaging with bicycle safety messaging.

The first event will take place on Tuesday, October 7, 2025, at 3:30PM in the parking lot of the Summit Family Aquatic Center, located at 100 Ashwood Avenue. The second event will take place on Thursday, October 9, 2025, at 3:30PM at Tatlock Park, located at 90 Butler Parkway, in the paved area between the tennis courts and Investors Bank Field.

These events are part of the Mayors Wellness Campaign. Representatives from Avenues in Motion will perform helmet fit checks and basic bicycle maintenance inspections. Participants can ride through an obstacle course and visit stations that will highlight various bicycle skills and safety scenarios riders may encounter on the road. This event is also a great opportunity to learn about the city's new bike and e-bike [ordinances](#).

“It’s crucial that our young residents have the knowledge and skills to safely bike around town,” says Summit Mayor Elizabeth Fagan, MD. “One of the goals of the Mayors Wellness Campaign is to promote physical well-being and increased physical activity among our residents, and safety is an important part of that.
