ON STREET METERS & KIOSKS

To locate on-street parking with 3, 5 and 12-hour parking limits, call 908-522-5100. FREE 15-minutes available at 90-minute spaces. All on-street parking is FREE after 6pm, Sundays and holidays.

Bike racks are available at both ends of the train station.

HOURLY PARKING

Lots #1, 2 and 3 DeForest Avenue Lots
Monday thru Saturday, 8am-6pm
Pay when you first park at kiosk or with Parkmobile.
First Hour free then graduating hourly fee.
Lot #4 2-hours and 30-minute spaces, paid parking
Lot #5 90-minute and 15-minute spaces, paid parking

Additional weekend parking

Lots #6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13
FREE on Saturday and Sunday, no permit required.
No overnight parking in any lots without a Summit overnight resident permit. No overnight parking in lot 1.

RESIDENT COMMUTER PARKING

Lots #6, 7, 8 and 9
Daily parking fee: \$4 per day, Monday thru Friday from 4am to 6pm, permit required
FREE on Saturday and Sunday, no permit required
Discounts available for quarterly & annual prepaid parking

DOWNTOWN EMPLOYEE PARKING

Lots #6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12
Daily parking fee: \$4 per day, Monday thru Friday from 4am to 6pm, permit required
FREE on Saturday and Sunday, no permit required
Discounts available for quarterly & annual prepaid parking

DOWNTOWN STREET METER PARKING

Street spaces are FREE on Sundays and certain Holidays. All time limits and fees are posted on meters.

NON-RESIDENT COMMUTER PARKING OPTIONS

Lot #6 Upper level of the Broad Street Garage
Daily fee required, no permit required. No overnight parking permitted, FREE on Sat. and Sun. and certain Holidays.
Lot #14 Park & Rail, 24-hour parking up to 5 days, Daily fee required. No overnight parking permitted, FREE on Sat. and Sun. and certain Holidays.
Lot #15 Park & Ride (bus), \$3 per day to park
Prepaid discounts require a permit.
Contact Parking Services Agency for permit information.
No overnight parking permitted.

LIBRARY/YMCA LOT

Lot #16 Monday thru Saturday, 8am-6pm
Three-hour and 30-minute parking is available for Library and YMCA patrons only.

PARKING PERMITS

To obtain a digital permit for residents or downtown employees, applicants must submit the application with valid vehicle registration and include insurance card (if vehicle is leased). Downtown employees must have the owner or manager sign the application. All can be done on-line.

Summit residents must physically live in the Summit residence in order to qualify for a permit. New residents, please refer to the application for all information required. Forms and requirements are available at cityofsummit.org or call 908-522-5100.

Overnight parking permits in the Business District are available for Summit residents only for a quarterly fee. Applicants must present a valid vehicle registration, insurance card, and copy of a current lease.

Permits are available for the Park & Ride (Lot #15) at the Parking Services Agency. Visit cityofsummit.org for forms and mailing information. Applicants must present with application, a valid vehicle registration, insurance card, and payment.

VISITOR PASSES

Contractors doing business in the Central Retail Business District should pre-purchase Daily Visitor Passes for long-term daily parking from the Parking Services Agency at City Hall. Visitor passes may not be used in the DeForest Lots.

BAGGED METERS/DUMPSTER PERMITS

With 72-hours notice, downtown employers, utility companies and certain contractors may bag street meters or request a dumpster permit in the Central Retail Business District. Fees and restrictions apply. For information and pricing contact the Parking Services Agency at 908-522-5100.

All pay-by-cell information is on cityofsummit.org. Available at all municipal parking locations and at all street spaces. A convenience fee applies to any customer using Parkmobile for each transaction.

ENFORCEMENT

Parking Services Agency enforces all metered areas (on and off-street) within Summit's Business District to make parking available to the maximum number of people. Please adhere to regulations and parking time limits—no meter feeding or meter jumping.

HANDICAPPED PARKING

Downtown Summit has handicapped parking spaces available for drivers with a visible VALID handicap placard or plates. If a handicapped space is not available, you may park at any street meter or in any lot (excluding permit-required lot). Per NJ State law, (C.39:4-207). The driver with a placard or handicapped license plate must put the appropriate amount of money in the meter or payment kiosk. If the vehicle will occupy the space for more than the maximum amount that the meter holds, the driver must fill the meter to the maximum amount. If you are parked in the gated lots on DeForest you will pay the hourly fee for the entire time you are parked. In the long-term lots you need to pay the daily fee and have a permit, if required.

PARKING HOLIDAYS IN SUMMIT

On annual parking holidays, New Years Day, Martin Luther King Day, Presidents' Day, Memorial Day, Juneteenth, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day, parking is FREE in long-term lots and at street spaces. BICYCLE PARKING & LOCKERS

Complimentary bike racks are available for commuters and residents at locations on Union Place and Railroad Avenue sides of the Summit Train Station. Consider leaving your car at home and riding your bicycle.

ON-LINE SERVICES

Visit Parking Services Agency on-line at www.cityofsummit.org to pre-pay long-term parking with a major credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover), a parking permit is required.

RIDESHARE PROGRAM AVAILABLE

Residents working in the downtown or commuting must pre-register for the program and have a valid Summit parking permit. More information at cityofsummit.org.
