#### DISPOSITION CATEGORIES

Sustained: Investigation disclosed sufficient evidence to prove allegation by preponderance of evidence.

Exonerated: Alleged incident did occur, but actions of the officer were justified, legal and proper.

Not Sustained: Investigation failed to disclose sufficient evidence to clearly prove or disprove allegation.

Unfounded: The alleged incident did not occur.

Administratively Closed: In some cases, the complaint or investigation is closed prior to reaching a disposition. These are counted as "Administratively Closed." Examples include situations when a complainant voluntarily requests that a complaint be withdrawn, or the subject officer terminates his or her employment prior to disposition of the complaint.
