Preview of June 1 Common Council meeting agenda by Council President Marjorie Fox

The next Common Council meeting will be held on **Wednesday**, June 1 at 7:30 PM in Council Chamber at City Hall.

Council will hold hearings and vote on two bond ordinances to fund the 2022 Capital Budget and the sewer utility budget. Council will also hold a hearing and vote on a Finance Committee ordinance to establish salary ranges for all city employees.

Council will hold a hearing on a single ordinance to amend the city code to require the installation of key lock box emergency access systems to allow the fire department emergency access to buildings where occupants might not be present to provide entry.

The Safety Committee will introduce an ordinance to amend a portion of the key lock box ordinance concerning compliance (section 16-3.5), as the earlier ordinance was inconsistent with the Uniform Construction Code.

Council will consider two Finance Committee resolutions to authorize 2022 salaries. One of the resolutions will address salaries retroactive to January 1 based on a 2.25% cost of living adjustment for those employees who have reached the top of the step guide and adjustments for department heads. The second resolution sets forth salaries effective July 1, based on step and longevity increases.

Council will consider three Law and Labor resolutions to renew 2022-2023 liquor licenses. The first resolution includes three categories of liquor licenses. The second resolution is for the Elks Club license renewal. Because several members of council are also members of the Elks Club, it is necessary to follow the "conflicts license" procedure, which refers the licensure decision back to the state Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control.

The Capital Projects and Community Services Committee will introduce two resolutions. The first resolution authorizes the advertisement for a hearing to close out open assessments for curb and sidewalk improvements in past capital projects. The hearing will be held on June 15. The second resolution awards the 2022 micro-surfacing project through the City of Summit Cooperative Pricing System to Asphalt Paving Systems in an amount not to exceed \$86,915.66.
