Preview of November 14 Common Council meeting agenda by Council President Marjorie Fox

The next Common Council meeting will be held on Monday, November 14 at 7:30 PM in Council Chamber at City Hall.

Council will hear an affordable housing presentation by Matthew DiLauri, Assistant Director, Operations & Planning, Department of Community Services, and Nancy Holm, Esq, the city's affordable housing attorney. There will be an opportunity for the public to ask questions.

The Community Programs and Parking Services Committee will introduce three related ordinances to amend the code to: (1) add six employee parking spaces on the north side of Broad Street from Walnut Street to Park Avenue; (2) change the time limit from 90 minutes to 30 minutes on meters on the north side of Union Place; and (3) change the time limit from 90 minutes to 15 minutes at various locations throughout the downtown. These changes to the time limits are intended to provide for more turnover of the parking spaces and prevent dangerous parking practices, such as double parking and parking in crosswalks, in the downtown. The hearings will be held on December 6.

The Safety Committee will introduce resolutions to appoint a police lieutenant and a new police officer.
